Workshops

I'm excited about hosting our first Workshop prior to Region and will have more feedback for you after the workshop. I attended Southern California's Regional Assembly Workshop in February and participated in their SPAD workshop to get ideas for our workshop. At the event I was able to connect with Pam from NAWs who sent us a package of materials for today's workshop.

Hopefully we will be able to get the meeting room in Greater Mojave at 11 am in May so that we can conduct another workshop (we will need tables for participants). I am also willing to create another flyer for that Regional Sunday if I can get the meeting location information before our April meeting.

WSC Participant Web Meeting

I signed on and attended the WSC Participant Web meeting on February 9th. There were 111 Participants including 2 NAWs staff members and a feed from the World Board with approximately 8 of our Board Members in one video.

After some brief introductions and presentation of topics for discussion we were broken out into smaller discussion groups. My group was comprised of 15 members from the US, Australia, England, Iran and a number of US locales.

In these groups we discussed three topics from the WSC of the Future Project:

1. Making the WSC Effective and Sustainable 2. Role of Zones 3. Zonal Collaboration

Our second discussion focused on the role of Zones and Zonal collaboration. One thing that became clear to me as discussion progressed is that in at least some other parts of the world, Zones play a role that is much closer to what our Region fulfills for us.

There was good discussion about the value of Zonal collaboration, including practicing prudence by sharing the cost and burden of providing trusted servants required for specific tasks between zones, even when one zone could potentially provide a service on its own.
